

Applying for funding to attend Faraday Courses

Christians in Science has a limited number of bursary places available to allow CiS student members to attend courses at The Faraday Institute for Science and Religion for free. CiS will pay for your place directly. These will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis each year.

If you would like to apply for a grant to attend one of the courses you can do so in the following way:

- Write no more than 500 words about yourself, your background (briefly), why you are applying and what you would like to get out of this course.
- Please also include details of:
 - The specific course you would like to attend, and whether you require accommodation
 - Your university course
 - Your involvement with CiS so far
- The courses fill up quickly, so submit your document to the CiS Secretary at secretary@cis.org.uk in good time before the course.

Your bursary request will then be processed by a small sub-committee, who will let you know if your application has been successful. If you are successful you will be required to write a short report for the CiS committee after the course, outlining what you got out of attending.

This bursary is only available to CiS members; however, you can sign up for a free year of student membership as part of your application.

Course and Accommodation

CiS will pay Faraday directly for the course (and accommodation if required).

Reimbursement of travel costs

The applicant will need to arrange and pay for any travel required. CiS will reimburse the applicant when we have received the receipts. If the receipts have been sent to the applicant via email, please forward the email to the secretary. If the receipts are in paper form, please scan and then email them. CiS would be looking for travel costs of a reasonable nature i.e. standard train fare or coach. Depending on the location of the applicant, air fares will be considered, if these prove to be cost effective, though we can only cover costs within the UK.

Nonattendance of course

Whether this is due to illness or other circumstances, please notify Faraday and the Development Officer as soon as possible, if you are unable to attend the course.
